- •Charcoal
- Eraser
- •Black Indian or acrylic ink and a fine tip brush
- Painter's tape: delicate low tack (purple coloured tape recommended)
- •Pen, pencils and notebook
- A range of brushes. Recommended for watercolour:
 - A mop brush JASART mop brush in size 6 or 12, or a Da Vinci Casaneo wash brush.

A round and a flat brush - Da Vinci Cosmotop Spin or Casaneo watercolour brushes are good.

- •Watercolour paint in a range of colours, recommended to buy tubes, but a small set /pans is also fine
- •paper towels and rag
- Palette knife
- •Acrylic paint in a selection of colours (optional)
- •Painting medium: gel, gloss or matt medium for acrylics (optional)
- •An A4 and an A3 scale canvas or canvas board (optional)
