Materials list

Painting with Open Acrylics - with Kathy Barber

A basic kit of materials to get you up and going is listed here. Specialist art shops are the best option and will provide student discounts if you mention that you are attending the school. The stores we recommend are:

- **Studio Art Supplies**, Crummer Road, Grey Lynn
- **Gordon Harris**, Gillies Avenue, Newmarket and Symonds Street, Auckland Central

Materials required:

- Golden Open Acrylic 59ml tubes. At least two colours of your choice, not White
- Golden Open Thinner (30ml bottle is fine)
- A pad of watercolour paper.
e.g. Hahnemüle Britannia HP Watercolour paper 300gsm A3ish 12 sheets
- Masking tape (low tack)
- 2 x Bulldog clips
- A selection of brushes, (@8) a couple of wide 6cm, a couple of medium and any more you like to work with. These can be the cheap bristle brushes – just whatever you have.
- Water bottle for mist spraying - cheap e.g. from Payless Plastics
- A plastic squeeze water bottle - cheap e.g. from Payless Plastics

Optional: Calligraphy brushes

At Browne School of Art, we also have a selection of basic materials available for purchase: paper in A2/A3 Sheets, newsprint, cartridge, sugar grey, wet strength, bulldog clips, pencils charcoal, erasers, white chalk, black ink
