A basic kit of materials to get you up and going is listed here. Specialist art shops are the best option and will provide student discounts if you mention that you are attending the school.

The stores we recommend are:

Materials required:

It's not necessary to have all of the following, ensure you bring pencils, pens and colour to use:

- A3 pad, at least 110gsm or above
- A5 or A4 journal (no lines, not too many pages)
- assorted: acrylic paints, water colours, marker pens, or coloured pencils
- pencils: HB / 2B
- eraser
- 300mm clear ruler
- black fine-tipped ink pens, a range of sizes
- a poem, short story or song lyrics for reference to inspire illustrations
- photographic reference, that relates to the written words (can be on photocopied paper)
e.g. houses, plants, land/seascapes, animals, birds ... (these will be your drawing inspiration)
